Update on Oregon HB 4145 and Proposed -9 Amendment

Today, **Oregon HB 4145** received a proposed “-9 Amendment” from Democratic Senate leadership. This amendment would remove nearly all of the bill’s substantive provisions. The only significant change that remains is a modification to the implementation date of Oregon Ballot Measure 114, moving it from December 8, 2022, to January 1, 2028.

While this amendment does not eliminate Measure 114, it would delay its implementation by approximately two additional years. According to supporters of the amendment, the delay is intended to allow more time to address legal and constitutional questions surrounding the measure.

Legislative leaders appear to recognize that both **Measure 114** and the proposed expansions contained in **HB 4145** face significant legal challenges and practical implementation issues. These concerns are heightened by ongoing litigation, including:

- A pending case before the Oregon Supreme Court arising from a challenge filed in Harney County.
- Federal lawsuits currently before the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit, which are evaluating the measure in light of recent United States Supreme Court decisions affecting Second Amendment law.

Aside from the delayed implementation date, the remaining language in HB 4145 is largely procedural. One provision states that the legislature does not intend for the bill to affect the current Harney County case now pending before the Oregon Supreme Court.

March Rimfire Match

There were six shooters at the March Rim Fire match. Match conditions were fair with very little wind and precipitation. Final scores had JD Conn in first with 500-15Xs, Robert Hoogenstryd in second with 500-14Xs, and Wes Jackson in third with 499-23Xs.
